

## Birth, Babies and Beyond Ordering a Birth Certificate

Your midwives will submit your child's birth certificate for you. You will not automatically receive your child's birth certificate in the mail. After you receive your child's social security card in the mail (takes a few weeks after the birth) you can order online, by mail or by walking in.

### **For Washington residence:**

If you live in Washington you will need to fill out the first page of the Birth Certificate worksheet and give to your midwives by the three day postpartum visit.

For Washington the fee is \$20 for mail order and walk in order and 31.50 for online ordering.

### **For Oregon residence :**

You will need to fill out the Birth Certificate Worksheet, including the Social Security authorization form.

For Oregon the fee is \$20 for mail orders, \$23.50 for walk in orders, \$36.50 for online orders.
