INSURANCE CLAIM

We will file a claim with your health plan, and they will send you an Explanation of Benefits (EOB). The EOB is **not a bill**.



PATIENT RESPONSIBILITY

In most cases there is no additional patient responsibility. If there is, **we'll call you** before sending a bill.

The average patient responsibility is \$185 after deductibles are met.¹



OUR COMMITMENT

During our call, we will evaluate your personal financial situation, answer any questions you may have about your bill, and discuss payment options.²

To qualify for financial assistance, your annual household income cannot exceed the amounts listed. However, other payment options may be available under the *Peace of Mind* program.
